

# Joel 3

## Chapter 3

<sup>1</sup> FOR, behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem,

<sup>2</sup> I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and *for* my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and parted my land.

<sup>3</sup> And they have cast lots for my people; and have given a boy for an harlot, and sold a girl for wine, that they might drink.

<sup>4</sup> Yea, and what have ye to do with me, O Tyre, and Zidon, and all the coasts of Palestine? will ye render me a recompence? and if ye recompense me, swiftly *and* speedily will I return your recompence upon your own head;

<sup>5</sup> Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

<sup>6</sup> The children also of Judah and the children of Jerusalem have ye sold unto the Grecians, that ye might remove them far from their border.

<sup>7</sup> Behold, I will raise them out of the place whither ye have sold them, and will return your recompence upon your own head:

<sup>8</sup> And I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the children of Judah, and they shall sell them to the Sabeans, to a people far off: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.

<sup>9</sup> ¶ Proclaim ye this among the Gentiles; Prepare war, wake up the mighty men, let all the men of war draw near; let them come up:

<sup>10</sup> Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruninghooks into spears: let the weak say, I *am* strong.

<sup>11</sup> Assemble yourselves, and come, all ye heathen, and gather yourselves together round about: thither cause thy mighty ones to come down, O LORD.

<sup>12</sup> Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about.

<sup>13</sup> Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the fats overflow; for their wickedness *is* great.

<sup>14</sup> Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD *is* near in the valley of decision.

<sup>15</sup> The sun and the moon shall be darkened, and the stars shall withdraw their shining.

<sup>16</sup> The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD *will be* the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.

<sup>17</sup> So shall ye know that I *am* the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

<sup>18</sup> ¶ And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.

<sup>19</sup> Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence *against* the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

<sup>20</sup> But Judah shall dwell for ever, and Jerusalem from generation to generation.

<sup>21</sup> For I will cleanse their blood *that* I have not cleansed: for the LORD dwelleth in Zion.
